WHATISTOYOTA GAZOO RACING?

TOYOTA GAZOO Racing's history extends back over more than 20 years.

Initially the brainchild of Toyota president Akio Toyoda, it began when he introduced a revolutionary system that used photos to better engage with dealers and increase customer satisfaction when launching a new vehicle. Although this was not recognised as an official Toyota activity, the Japanese word for photograph is gazō, and hence TOYOTA GAZOO was born.

In 2017, Toyota competed in the 24 hour Nürburgring race to enhance the development of its cars. While this race was taken on the belief that motorsports could help strengthen both human resources and the cars, it was also not an official Toyota activity. So rather than use the company name, it became the GAZOO Racing team.

Today, TOYOTA GAZOO Racing is a symbol of revolution and challenge: a new challenge for a new age that begins here. The challenges and insights TOYOTA GAZOO Racing team learn on the track allow Toyota to improve not just race cars, but also enhance the road cars you see today.

The TGRA GR CUP is Australia's premier affordable motor racing series. It showcases Toyota's passion for cars and people.

Two invited professional drivers will compete against a potential field of more than 30 drivers, mentored by one full-time dedicated motorsport expert. Races share billing in selected Supercars rounds and have been sanctioned by Motorsport Australia.

Like similar one-make series races, the TGRA GR CUP demands competition adhere to a strict car setup, ensuring that driver talent, rather than team budget is key to winning.

2025 marks the third year of the TGRA Scholarship Series and we couldn't be more excited to welcome a host of new drivers and teams to join our ever-growing TOYOTA GAZOO Racing community.

As a second tier, entry-level series for aspiring professional race drivers or those who just want to test their own mettle on the track, it has proved an enormous success and will again be run over five state-level events in Victoria, New South Wales, Queensland and South Australia, with drivers lining up on the grid in the Toyota 86.

The Scholarship Series offers a perfect opportunity for newcomers to the sport or those wanting to graduate out of karts to learn through, and experience, the thrill of tight racing action in a safe and exciting environment.




